

Writing for Fun Club (*Klabb Kitba Kreattiva*)

The National Literacy Agency is organizing *Klabb Kitba Kreattiva* for children in **Year 4 to Year 8** who wish to strengthen their writing skills. This activity is mainly targeted at children who have completed the Nwar Programme.

The aim of the club is to encourage children to develop their creative writing skills, and express their thoughts in writing. Parents, guardians, or grandparents attend together with their children to learn how to help their child develop their writing skills.

An exhibition and closure celebration is organized at the end of the club. A certificate of completion is given to those participants who attend regularly (80%) and complete the course successfully.
