All registrants are requested to read the participation guidelines attached to this letter circular. Interested students are also to showcase their illustration skills by submitting one original illustration to the sample story, attached to this letter circular.

### **Registrations are to be submitted by Friday 23rd July 2021.**

Following review by a team of DLAP Education Officers, 2 students (one from the Primary and another from the Middle/Secondary level) will be selected for the actual illustration tasks. Student selection is determined by the quality and style of their artwork.

Selected students will be subsequently guided to create 12 illustrations each, by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Each of these two students will be awarded with a €300 voucher redeemable at a local art store.
