

Year 1 Stationery List

- UHU Stick
- Small round tip scissors
- Plastic pocket folder (thickness 1 inch)
- Cardboard pocket folder
- Plastic crayons (not thick) in a separate pencil case
- Colouring book
- A4 drawing book
- Paint brush (flat and 2cm width)
- Art apron (an old t-shirt will do)
- Black whiteboard marker
- A4 laminated white paper
- Pencil case which should hold: a rubber, small ruler, sharpener and 3 pencils
- 2 dice
- Single pack of playing cards
- 10 ice lolly sticks (new please).
- 10 water bottle or soft drink caps. Must be of the same colour and size and put in a small plastic bag
- A4 blue button folder
- A box of tissues, a large pack of wipes and hand sanitizer.
- 4 wide lined copybooks; 2 of them covered in blue (Labelled Maths 1 and Maths 2)
- 6 narrow lined copybooks - (not with red lines). *It is important that these have a margin and not more than 12 lines in each page.*
 - 2 red covers (Labelled English 1 and English 2 respectively)
 - 2 green covers (Labelled Malti 1 and Malti 2 respectively)
 - 1 yellow cover (Labelled Handwriting)

- 1 white cover (Labelled Extra Work)
- 2 narrow lined copybooks - with each page divided into 5 columns - You buy these readymade. Green cover (Labelled Malti 1 u Malti 2 respectively)
- Blank copybook covered with coloured gift paper and plastic (Labelled Journal)

Each of your child's belongings should be labelled with his/her name and copybooks should preferably have thick covers.
