On the 5th and 6th March [Sean Briffa](#) and Jeremy Grech will explain how it is not just us humans who have emotions, other animals share a range of feelings, such as fear, jealousy, sadness, excitement and so on. This performance engages the audience using humour, larger than life personalities and by testing their ability to work things out for themselves. The idea is to create a generation of caring, active citizens who will protect and safeguard our environment now and in the years to come.

What we're really excited about this year is the collaboration with NGOs working to support the habitats of our unique flora and fauna, ensuring young audiences are equipped with all they need to know. Helping them become the superheroes we need to save our planet, one small step at a time.
