Call for Christmas Card Drawings

from the Office of the Prime Minister

INTRODUCTION

As the Christmas season approaches, the Office of the Prime Minister, in collaboration with Arts Council Malta and Spazju Kreattiv, is issuing a call for drawings to be featured on the official 2022 Office of the Prime Minister Christmas Card.

This call for drawings is in line with an outreach programme which the OPM, together with the supporting entities, has embarked on to provide young people with further opportunities and access to the arts and creativity.



SUBMISSIONS

This call is open to all young people aged between 4 and 16 who are residents of Malta. Each applicant may submit one design with an accompanying message.

Submissions must be made by a parent or guardian on behalf of the participants. Each drawing should be accompanied by a card greeting message which is to be written at the back of the drawing. To submit your designs, please follow these three steps:

- 1. Write your name, age, and contact details on the back of each drawing;
- 2. Download, print, and fill-in the submission online form;
- 3. Send your drawing and application form by post or deliver them by hand to the address below by the deadline 30th November 2022:

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS

- Medium: Participants may use any medium or combination of media (excluding sculpture, 3D and audio-visual) including paint, crayon, pencil, collage, and digital media
- Theme: Christmas. Be creative and let your imagination run free!
- Size: A4 drawings



REWARDS

Rewards will be given to four different age groups for the best card design and for the best message. The age groups are: 4 to 6, 7 to 10, 11 to 13, and 14 to 16. The winning design and the winning message from each age group will be selected for the official Office of the Prime Minister Christmas Card designs.

Furthermore, winners will receive the following gifts:

- Arts resources
- Tickets for Ziguzajg and Spazju Kreattiv 2022/23 season
- Exhibition: All entries will be exhibited at Spazju Kreattiv.

CRITERIA

The designs to be used for the OPM 2022 Christmas cards will be selected by a jury appointed by Arts Council Malta according to the criteria below.

- Creativity and originality in addressing the theme and in use of artistic materials and techniques
- Artistic skill
- Relevance to theme



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering the competition, each winning entrant grants the Office of the Prime Minister and the partnering entities an irrevocable, perpetual licence to reproduce, enlarge, crop, publish or exhibit, mechanically or electronically and on any media, the submitted designs.

By entering the competition, the guardian confirms that the drawings and card greeting message submitted are the original work of the young people participating. All copyright and any other intellectual property rights in the artwork scanned are vested in the young people and they have not assigned, licensed, or disposed of or otherwise encumbered any of their rights in the artwork. The guardian also confirms the artwork and greetings does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party in respect of the artwork.

The call is governed by GDPR regulations.
