During the summer months, the National Literacy Agency will be offering a summer edition of the Footballers' Read and Write Programme / *Bil-Qari u l-Kitba Niskorja*.

Past cycles have shown that by the end of the programme most participants improve their reading skills. The FRWP sessions combine the children's love and passion for football with reading and writing, thus motivating them to read and better their overall language skills.

A limited number of pupils will be accepted. An informal interview will be held with all applicants as part of the selection process prior to the start of the programme. The ten sessions are going to be held once a week, from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at St Venera Ground, Hamrun.
