

Year 3 – Stationery List 2025 – 2026

The following is a basic list of stationery needs for Year 3 pupils starting in September 2025. Each teacher may request some other items at the beginning of the year. Kindly ensure all items are clearly labelled with the child's name and surname.

- ☐ A wide-lined copybook with a blue cover labelled Maths
- ☐ A narrow-lined copybook (without red lines) with a green cover labelled Malti 1
- ☐ A narrow-lined copybook (without red lines) with a green cover labelled Malti 2
- ☐ A narrow-lined copybook (without red lines) with a red cover labelled English
- ☐ A narrow-lined copybook (without red line) with a white cover labelled Extra Work
- ☐ A4 Plastic box file - 1 inch wide – Labelled Homework Folder
- ☐ Button Folder – Yellow – Label Library Book
- ☐ 2 Button Folders – any colour
- ☐ Flat File Yellow Label Reading Log
- ☐ Storage box with lid (measuring approximately 40 cm 3 30 cm x 20 cm – 16 litres; it is important that an A4 paper fits in it)
- ☐ 6 A4 transparent plastic covers
- ☐ 3 Pencils
- ☐ Sharpener
- ☐ Eraser
- ☐ Green pen
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ 2 Highlighters (any colour)
- ☐ Blue erasable pen
- ☐ 2 transparent rulers: one large and one small
- ☐ Pencil colours
- ☐ Glue stick
- ☐ A4 mini whiteboard with eraser
- ☐ 2 Whiteboard markers, different colours
- ☐ 10 A4 Cardboard sheets: 3 black, 2 red, 2 green and 3 other colours
- ☐ A4 Drawing book with perforated sheets
- ☐ Wet wipes

- ☐ Hand sanitizer

Please note that all copybooks need to have a margin. Metal pencil cases are not allowed. Instead, we suggest using a simple pencil case with 2 zippers at the top, one for regular stationery and the other for pencil colours.

The following items will be used during maths lessons and should be in an A4 zipper folder:

- ☐ 2 dice
- ☐ Small button folder/Wallet with the following coins:
 - 10 – 1c
 - 10 – 2c
 - 10 – 5c
 - 10 - 10c
 - 5 – 20c
 - 2 - 50 c
