

## Year 2 – Stationery List 2026 – 2027

The following is a basic list of stationery needs for Year 2 pupils starting in September 2026. Each teacher may request some other items at the beginning of the year. Kindly ensure all items are clearly labelled with the child's name and surname.

- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in white and label “English Vocabulary”
- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in red and label “English”
- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in green and label “Malti”.
- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in purple and label “Malti Vokabularju”.
- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in covered in fancy or wrapping paper, label “Journal”
- 1 Narrow-lined copybook covered in yellow, label “Spelling”
- 2 Extra narrow-lined copybooks, with no cover but label with the child's name.
- 2 Extra wide-lined copybooks labelled “Maths”
- 1 Graph copybook (1cm square) covered in brown and label “Maths”
- 1 Wide-lined copybook covered in blue cover and label “Maths 1”
- A4 scrapbook (colour pages only). Cover creatively and label “Science”
- A4 project book (alternate pages with narrow lines and colour). Cover creatively and label “Writing/Kitba”

### Other stationery

- A4 zipped pocket for Maths toolbox containing:
  - A pack of playing cards
  - 30 (unused) lollipop sticks in a pouch
  - 3 dice in a container/pouch
  - Number grid 1-100
  - Number line 1-20
  - Purse with 30 x 1c coins, 10 x 2c coins, 10 x 5c coins, 10 x 10c coins, 5 x 20c coins, 2 x 50c coins, 1 x €1 coin
- 1 Drawing books A4
- Pencil case with a pencil, ruler (15 cm), rubber and sharpener
- Crayons in a separate pencil case to be kept in class

- Glue stick
- Scissors
- A4 pocket file - This should be wide enough to hold exercise books and workbooks to help keep the school bag tidy.
- Whiteboard
- 2 Whiteboard markers
- Whiteboard eraser

At the start of year 2 it would be helpful if:

- Children can put on and take off their own jacket.
- Water bottles are water tight
- Schoolbags should be big enough to hold the necessary folder. Stiff to keep its shape and with compartments. This will help the children learn to be independent.

Children ready for year 2 should be able to:

- Recognise and write numbers to 20 and know their value.
- Read and write the letters of the alphabet in Maltese and English and the corresponding sound.
- Can read year 1 Tricky Words.
- Add and subtract numbers up to 10.
